SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The Climate Change Institute (CCI) accepts nominations for THE CHURCHILL AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING EXPLORATION annually. This award is open to CCI students who have received funding from the Dan & Betty Churchill Exploration Fund. Applicants will be expected to present an overview of their research activities supported by the Churchill Exploration Fund at the Borns Symposium for review by the Churchill Award Committee.

Presentations will be judged on the following criteria:

- 1) Quality of Communication (is the talk clear and accessible to an education non-specialist public?).
- 2) Quality, Impact and Originality of the Research

Awardee will receive a framed certificate and an invitation to dine with the members of the CCI Churchill Committee. Award will be presented at the annual Borns Symposium.

Eligibility: Any student who has carried out field research with support from a Churchill Exploration Grant.

Students who received Churchill funding in the last year's cycle must give an oral presentation on their Churchill-funded research and will be entered automatically. If you received a Churchill award in an earlier cycle and wish to be considered for the Churchill Award, please fill out the information below and submit this form with a copy of your upcoming Borns abstract to Dan Sandweiss (dan.sandweiss@maine.edu) by April 10.
